PURPOSE

KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

3. Late observations, consultation responses, information and revisions have been received in respect of the following items on the agenda:

In paragraphs 23 and 24 of the published response to the petition,

23. On the timed- access restriction along Dulwich Village, this was introduced in 2022 and was introduced as part of the Dulwich Streetspace and School Streets programme. Its primary purpose is road safety, and serves to protect pupils walking, wheeling, or cycling to school, and improving safety at the Dulwich Village / Calton Avenue junction for everyone.

24. We have been extremely targeted in how it operates. The restriction applies only to northbound traffic, and only at the start and end of the school day, and only during term time: 8–9am and 3–4:30pm, Monday to Friday.

The timings of the timed access restriction are incorrect, as they are enforced year-round, and do not only apply during term time. This addendum corrects the accuracy of this paragraph, a revised version of which is set out below:

24. We have been targeted in how it operates. The restriction applies only to northbound traffic, and only at the start and end of the school day, from 8–9am and 3–4:30pm, Monday to Friday.

4. Officers and petitioners separately identified the inaccuracy in the original report after the original report was published. This addendum corrects the record.
