RECOMMENDATION

1. That the cabinet consider whether to hear a deputation from the group Originally Peckham Voluntary Sector Forum (PVSF) in respect of the educational attainment level of African heritage children in Southwark, particularly Caribbean children.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

2. When considering whether to hear the deputation request, cabinet can decide
 - To receive the deputation at this meeting or a future meeting; or
 - That the deputation not be received; or
 - To refer the deputation to the most appropriate committee/sub-committee.
3. A deputation shall consist of no more than six people, including its spokesperson. Only one member of the deputation shall be allowed to address the meeting for no longer than five minutes. After this time cabinet members may ask questions of the deputation for up to five minutes. At the conclusion of the questions, the deputation will be shown to the public area where they may listen to the remainder of the open section of the meeting.

KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

Originally Peckham Voluntary Sector Forum (PVSF)

4. A deputation request has been submitted by the Originally Peckham Voluntary Sector Forum in respect of research they have undertaken into the educational attainment level of African heritage children in Southwark, particularly Caribbean children. The group have written a report and wish to present and share the outcome and recommendations of the research to the Council.

Community impact statement

5. The Southwark Constitution allows for deputations to be made by groups of people resident or working in the borough.

REASONS FOR URGENCY

6. The deputation request was received in line with the constitutional deadline for the receipt of deputation requests and is therefore eligible for consideration by cabinet as to whether or not to hear the deputation at this meeting.

REASONS FOR LATENESS

7. The deadline for the receipt of deputation requests was 9 May 2013, after the main cabinet agenda despatch on 3 May 2013. It has therefore not been possible to send out this report five clear days in advance of the meeting because of the need to ensure that all deputation requests received by the deadline were included in this report.
