#### **UPDATE**

#### **Harris Federation Free Schools**

- 2. The Education Funding Agency has acquired the former police station on Lordship Lane. This will become the permanent site for the Harris East Dulwich Free School.
- 3. Officers understand that the federation intends to open in September 2014 with two reception classes on a temporary site yet to be confirmed.
- 4. The new round of free schools given pre-opening approval in late January 2014 included a Harris Federation 2 form entry primary free school in Nunhead. The school has approval to open in September 2015.
- 5. A temporary and a permanent site are being sought by the EFA on behalf of the Harris Federation.
