#### **RECOMMENDATION**

1. That council assembly establishes the constitutional steering panel and appoints the chair and vice chair (see Appendix 1).

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

- The constitutional steering panel is responsible for reviewing and recommending amendments to the constitution. It is also responsible for making recommendations to council assembly for the award of the Honorary Freedom of the Borough and Honorary Aldermen and to recommend changes to the members' allowances scheme.
- 3. In 2013/14 council assembly established a panel with a membership comprising the group whip and two other members from the majority group and the whips of the other political groups represented on the council. In accordance with current practice groups can nominate a reserve to attend in the absence of a representative. Council assembly is also invited to appoint a chair and vice chair of the constitutional steering panel.

### **KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION**

4. The constitutional steering panel needs to be established at this meeting so that it can consider submitting any constitutional recommendations to council assembly on 11 June 2014.

5. Panels are not required to be proportionate. This is a matter of local choice for the local authority.
