Location	Comments	How issues have been addressed
Dulwich Village, Calton Avenue and Court Lane junction	Filter and timed closures making journeys longer for Dulwich residents.	Reduce hours of timed restrictions to school hours. Changing some filters to timed camera access .
Dulwich Village, Calton Avenue and Court Lane junction and Melbourne Grove (North)	Filter and timed closures leading to loss of passing trade for businesses.	Reduced hours of timed restrictions school hours. Parklets installed to support local businesses. Relocate Melbourne Grove (North) traffic filter on experimental basis.
All	Filter and closures making it harder for disabled/ill people to get about/get to medical services	Reduce hours of timed restrictions to school hours. Exemption for all Southwark Blue badge holders, and expand exemption policy.
All	Timed closures creating traffic on Croxted Road	Reduce hours of timed restrictions to school hours. On-going discussions with TfL and Lambeth to improve congestion in Herne Hill.
East Dulwich Area	Filters in East Dulwich and timed closure on Townley Road causing traffic on East Dulwich Grove , Lordship Lane and Grove Vale	Reduced hours of timed restrictions to school hours. Changing filter at Melbourne Grove (South) to timed camera access to distribute traffic evenly.
East Dulwich, and Calton Avenue and Court Lane junction	Access for emergency vehicles	Access to be provided via Derwent Grove and at Calton Avenue, Court Lane and Dulwich Village junction.

All	Difficulties for tradesmen, taxis and relatives of disabled/elderly residents in accessing addresses in the Village	<p>Reduced hours of timed restrictions.</p> <p>Changing some filters to timed camera access.</p> <p>Improve signage and introduce map based signs.</p>
Signage	Unclear signage leading to unfair fines both for locals, businesses and e.g. visiting family	Improve signage and introduce map based signs.
External Roads	Increased traffic on Grove Vale, East Dulwich Grove and Lordship Lane making shops/cafes there less desirable to visit	<p>Reduced hours of timed restrictions.</p> <p>Changing some filters to timed camera access.</p> <p>Engage with businesses and residents to agree relocation of Melbourne Grove (North) filter to improve access to shops.</p> <p>Loading /parking changes to ensure smooth flow of traffic.</p> <p>Increase enforcement in the area.</p> <p>Retain and improve parklet features.</p>
Turney Road	Timed closures leading to queuing and dangerous traffic e.g. Turney Road	Reduced hours of timed restrictions to distribute traffic evenly.
