I wish to object to this licence on the grounds that there are already too many establishments able to sell alcohol in this area. This particular shops (I am including what was Andrews and Robinson next door) were used for other purposes and closed at reasonable times.

There is now another wine shop across the road.

I am concerned the authority are not in a position to address any issues that may arise from granting this license. For example, I am aware the license team know of other breaches where shops remain open in breach of their license but do not enforce this breaches. The waste team do not stop businesses or enforce the dumping of their waste outside of agreed times despite proof. The noise team is not able to respond to noise issues in a reasonable period of time and the planning team are not able to respond to their own timescales when informed about planning breaches.

The above is a strong indicator that the area is now saturated and the authority is unable to ensure conditions are met,
