Southwark Council is proposing to review parking restrictions in your street.

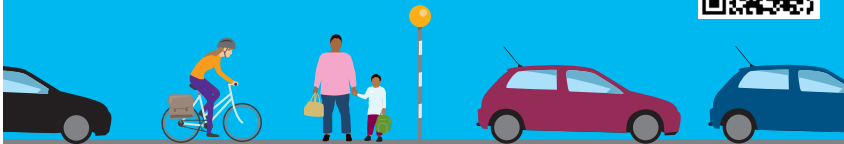

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Why are we doing this now?

Old Kent Road is preparing for significant development over the next decade, including up to 20,000 new homes. This area is likely to see higher levels of on street parking.

Benefits of a Parking Zone

The aim of a Parking Zone is to:

- Prioritise space for local residents, businesses and their visitors
- Prevent commuter parking
- Improve access for vehicles – especially emergency services and refuse vehicles
- Improve highway safety and reduce inconsiderate parking
- Enable 'permit-free' planning conditions to be placed upon future developments
- Reduce the dominance of parked cars on a street, enabling other use of that space

How does a Parking Zone work?

Permits will be required to park in the zone at the specified times.

These times can vary, and will be informed by your responses to us. Permits are available for residents within the zone, their visitors, and to businesses with an essential need for a permit.

How much will it cost?

A 12 month permit for residents is currently £125. Please see our website for a full schedule of costs: www.southwark.gov.uk/parking/parking-permits
