### Reviews and topics

- Review: Medical appointments – access to timely care and meeting patients' needs ( GP Appointments / A& E waiting times/ face to face physiotherapy etc.)
- Topic: Integrated Care System (ICS) and Partnership Southwark
- Review: Continue and complete the review started on the impact of pandemic and Brexit on the health and social care workforce, started during the previous administrative year. Evidence from unions and Human Resources on the impact of the pandemic, particularly burnout, will be sought, along with an update on Brexit.
