Details of Investigation**Additional submissions and summary of crime reports as requested from the interim steps notice of decision.**

Cris 3019609/22 refers to the incident from the morning of the 3rd July 2022.

Our position on this matter has not changed since my original submissions. There has been some terrible decision making from the staff at the premises on this night. From the details I have taken from the crime report it appears that staff including security were aware that this incident had occurred. However by the time Police had arrived the venue was locked and secure and no staff to be seen.

I have a witness account stating he saw the security team shutting down the venue whilst the victim lay in the street. This witness took footage from on his phone showing what was going on.

I briefly viewed this footage and could see the victim laying on the floor. Further up the alleyway I could see what appeared to be security from the venue standing outside by the entrance. At no point did I see the security approach the victim.

Unfortunately this witness does not want to provide a statement and is unwilling to assist any further. As the images were stored on his personal device and he no longer wishes to be a witness I am unable to show these images.

There remains confusion around the efforts made to contact the owner of the premises as stated on the crime report. A member of our night time economy team gave the details of the premises licence holder to the CID team, they then created a CAD for Hertfordshire Police to make contact.

At some point someone claiming to be the landlord from the premises has made contact with Hertfordshire Police and claimed they had been to the premises but it was closed. This cannot be the case as there was a Police presence outside the venue all night and into the following day.

I have seen nothing from the premises licence holder to explain this matter.

CRIS 3019509/22 refers to the incident on the 2nd July 2022

Our position on this has not changed since the initial submissions. CAD 1001 clearly shows it was the victim that called Police. His statement has not changed and as stated he left the premises and had to deal with the incident himself as staff were unwilling to assist.

In addition to the above I made reference to the following crimes reported

CRIS 3023563/21 refers to an incident on the 30/12/2021

A male entered the venue at 23.21 but due to him being intoxicated he was removed by the manager. This resulted in a fight where both parties made counter allegations of assault. The matter was closed as neither party wanted to substantiate any allegations.

CRIS 3034365/21 refers to an incident on the 12/12/2021 at 0330

Victim called Police stating he has been hit with a bottle at the venue. Victim had had a disagreement with the door staff due to not being allowed back in after closure to collect their coats.

Whilst outside the venue the victim has been hit with a bottle, unsure if it was thrown at him or someone hit him. No witnesses and report closed.

CRIS 3003415/22 refers to an incident that occurred on the 06/02/2022 at 0300 to 0330

Police were flagged down by security who explained a fight had broken out after asking a male to leave. Whilst waiting at the bar the victim has apparently pushed in front of the suspect. This has then turned into a fight inside the premises. Suspects and victim removed altercation continues outside, at which point the police arrived having been flagged down by security.

CRIS 3023563/21 refers to an incident on the 04/09/2021 at 0346

Police received a call from the LAS requesting their attendance to a male that had been seriously assaulted at the Kings Head Yard alleyway off Borough High Street.

It was reported the male had suffered 4 stab wounds and both hands de-gloved.

According to the crime report the victim had been inside the venue with friends, one of the friends was getting lots of attention from a group of males. In short the victim took offence to this and whilst outside the premises in the alleyway possibly confronted a group of males.

The victim was attacked receiving 4 stab wounds and de-gloved hand probably due to defending himself. The investigation has not confirmed if the suspects were the same as those inside, all we know is that the victim was inside the premises and was attacked outside.

One additional incident has occurred at the premises since initial application for review was submitted.

CRIS 301262/22

Location- GIUSEPPE'S RISTORANTE ITALIANO & PIZZERIA

On SATURDAY 15th JULY 2022 AS1N was in a marked police vehicle when the above CAD came out. Upon arrival at the address police found multiple members of the public outside the restaurant and then a member of staff called over to officers who went down into the main restaurant. Officers found VIW2 downstairs being accosted by customer at the restaurant shouting at him saying 'HE SHOULDN'T HIT WOMEN'. Officers then split both parties up and established that the male had nothing to do with the initial incident that police were called to. Officers then called VW1 who by this time had left the restaurant for her to come back and so we could establish what had gone on.

It was apparent that she was part of a larger group of friends at the restaurant who had been sat at 3(three) different tables, VIW1 had joined late and not eaten or drank anything whilst there. As the meals had ended the groups had gotten up to leave and VIW1 had left to the top part of the restaurant and at this point VIW2 went up to her and grabbed her arm to stop her from leaving. VIW1 said 'I HAVEN'T EATEN OR DRANK SO IM NOT PAYING' and then alleged that VIW2 punched her in the mouth twice causing a minor cut but when officers saw VIW1 there was minimal damage not needing any first aid. VIW2 also alleged that VIW1 had hit and scratched him during this altercation.

Both parties were separated and worked out that the bill had been paid. Once this was all sorted the group VIW1 was a part of moved away and the restaurant finished off cleaning up

When police spoke to both parties separately neither wanted to support police action and for this to be reported only. No statements were taken due to both parties not supporting police action

All of the above incidents have occurred in the early hours of the weekend often after 0300. This might well be down the levels of intoxication involved. Whilst not all of the above incidents can be attributed to the operation of the premises it still remains of concern that these serious incidents are occurring involving patrons that have been drinking inside the premises.

I ask the licensing sub committee to consider all of their options. I am aware that this is a very popular venue with lots of support from its patrons and has been a part of Southwark's night time economy for many years.

It is clear some changes need to be made both with staff and operational procedures. At the time of writing this summary, Police are still in discussions with the premises licence holder with regard to the possible changes to be made. Nothing has been agreed at this stage. I will inform licensing authority if anything changes.

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CID NIGHT DUTY UPDATE

On the 04/09/2021 a call was made to police by LAS at 03:46, requesting their attendance stating that there was male that had been seriously assaulted at the Kings Head Yard Alleyway off Borough High Street, SE1. It had then been reported that the male had suffered at least four stab wounds and both degloved hands. CID responded to the call and were provided with the following handover:

CAD 1136/04SEP21-Caller: LAS/000900/04092021

- Victim stabbed four times, with both degloved hands from what appears to be defensive wounds. LAS attend.

-

CAD 1284/04SEP21

- Royal London Hospital continuity CAD

- 2914AS as continuity officer

- Dr Hickman declared injuries not L/T or LC

From these CADS I understand this to be a victim whom has suffered stab wounds by unknown parties. Therefore by its very nature this job is serious and complex.

HANDOVER AT SCENE:

CID DS CARTER and I had arrived on scene at approximately 04:30am to which we had received a verbal handover by Inspector BLONDELL whom had given the following information:

- The victim had received at least four stab wounds down the Kings Head Yard Alleyway and had been taken to Royal London Hospital with continuity. Attempts had been made to speak to members of public at scene. However at the time of handover it had still been unclear what

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had happened.

VENUE:

Kings Head Yard SE1 is an alleyway running from Borough High Street. A scene had already been implemented in order to contain it so that entrance to this alleyway from the street was closed to members of public. The other ingress route into Kings Head Yard SE1 from White Hart Yard had also been closed off.

Either side to the entrance of the alleyway from Borough High Street is Holland and Barrett to its left and Ristorante Italiano to the right of it. On immediate entry into the alleyway to the right side is another entrance door which allows access into the downstairs area of Ristorante Italiano.

On walking past the Ristorante Italiano, an inner cordon had been erected. Just past this was a number of large waste bins, to which a large pool of blood was present. On the left side of the alleyway there was a large gate which was locked. On walking down the alleyway, I could see the bloodied footprint on the pavement.

On continuing down the alleyway, opposite the pavement with the bloodied footprint there was another substantial pool of blood near to the Kings Head Pub. With splatters of blood carrying on down the middle of the alleyway.

I have then seen outside of the FRANCIS HOUSE, a substantial amount of blood and clothing. Where the victim had collapsed on the floor. This had been corroborated by LAS and by initial attending officers.

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SCENE AND INITIAL ACTIONS:

Given the above cordons that had been put in place, there were officers standing on the external and internal cordon points. This was to ensure no members of the public entered the scene from the

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entrance point on Borough High Street as well as the entrance to the alleyway from White Hart Yard. The alleyway had largely been self-contained however.

I briefly spoke with each officer and informed them that no one was to enter the crime scene. As I could see forensic opportunities in the alleyway it was important to establish a common approach path and limit the number of officers entering the scene. DS Carter and I entered the scene wearing appropriate PPE (gloves) and I instructed officers not to touch anything and keep to walking to the right side of the alleyway, no one was to walk through the middle of the alleyway or the left hand scene due to risk of contamination. My rationale for entering the scene was to make an assessment for forensic opportunities and evidential retrieval of exhibits.

I checked that a crime scene log had been started by one of the uniform officers and it had. I made sure that my colleague and I were signed in when entering the crime scene.

I had also went into the Giuseppe restaurant side entrance to the downstairs area. It was here that I had seen a number of smashed glasses on the floor and the tables were in a state of disarray. In order to at this stage not rule out the possibility of the restaurant being part of the venue for the GBH, I instructed officers to prevent access into here in the interim.

At this stage, I deemed the priority action to be the securing of the scene and establishing if there were any outstanding weapons.

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FORENSIC STRATEGY:

I contacted SOCO to inform them of the above information regarding the forensic opportunities and begin to devise a forensic strategy. At this stage it was deemed necessary to get more information from the victim and any witnesses regarding exactly what happened and to decide if the size of the cordon was sufficient.

Therefore in consultation with them after briefing them about the incident and the findings with witnesses and the account provided by the victim. I was considering the following:

- Locating the weapon was a priority
- Considering the scene was captured taking into account potential ingress and egress routes.

I instructed SOCO to photograph the external crime scene on KINGS HEAD YARD-which is predominately blood and victims clothing which has been left in situ.

ND SOCO will brief ET SOCO on the evidence recovery of the VIW clothing along with his belongings which will require the drying room-his wallet, shoes, trousers, belt and t-shirt have all been cut off and are sodden with blood.

SOCO have stated that the basement of Giuseppe's won't be considered a crime scene until it is ruled in / out by reviewing CCTV – the basement area which is the nightclub, has extensive CCTV and the manager Massemeo needs to be spoken to regarding reviewing this CCTV. The basement club has a lot of broken glass, bottles and appears disturbed inside – tables are moved and it does appear as if an incident has occurred – the cleaner has clearly started sweeping up glass but was left and no person was found within the venue.

Blood like substance was located outside the male toilet

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door, blood smears on the door, a bloodied face mask is behind the toilet door along with blood like substance in the sink and along a table in the venue. It has been ruled out that the VIW has NOT returned to the venue and this MAY belong to suspects – however until CCTV is reviewed it is not clear.

Currently Giuseppe's remains a crime scene until further notice –

The luncheonette which is part of Giuseppe's and is on the borough high street – this has been opened and they have been advised they are not to use the kitchen area which forms part of the basement level.

The old kings head public house is not a crime scene but is within the scene – the landlord has returned stating he can view CCTV if he's allowed in – there is no CCTV on the external.

After containment of the alleyway, a GP dog had been requested in order to search the area for weapons or anything that may have been discarded by the suspect. This had a negative result.

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The victim's account was filmed on body-worn. Due to the treatment of his injuries being ongoing it was deemed not appropriate to take a full written account at this stage:

V1 was awake and talking. V1 stated to police that he was with two girls at the club, Giuseppe. V2 and her sister V3. Because he was in the club with the girls, they were attracting unwanted attention from other males. V1 had told the girls not to be stupid and that the guys were only after one thing. The girls went out for a cigarette so he followed them out. As they were chatting to some guys, V1 felt that the guys had gone too far. To which V1 has then told them to stop. Following this, he has then been punched by a guy and then found himself on the floor. V1 remembers being kicked by a guy but is not certain where he was hit or kicked.

He stated that he did not recognise them at all other than that they were two white males and in his opinion it had not been a group. But that he was not sure if these two males were the same guys that were in the club. He said he might have had a disagreement with the girls in the club but doesn't remember having any strong disagreement with the guys in the club. But when it was outside it had turned ugly. He stated that didn't recognise them and wouldn't be able to recognise them again. Further

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stating that V2 had been there the whole time. V1 did not see the knife but had felt something sharp.

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VICTIM MEDICAL TREATMENT

The victim's injuries was declared as non-life threatening nor life changing by Dr at 08:04am. He had been taken to Royal London Hospital by a continuity officer 2194AS

172 medical form has been signed

Injuries are the following:

Right ear has been slashed

Right hand side of neck has been slashed

Left upper chest has a stab injury and has a drain in currently

Left hand has defensive slash wound

It was made clear that no officers from the crime scene were to have contact with the victim to avoid cross-contamination.

Due to the victims injuries meaning that he was largely covered up, body-mapping was unable to be completed.

WITNESSES:

Gave an account but was unsure about whether to provide a statement. Was inebriated at the time of being spoken to. States that she was out for a drink with her sister V2 and her boss. They were in a "nightclub" which is the downstairs restaurant area of Giuseppe's Pizza Place, access to which is down an alleyway off the main road by Borough Market and London Bridge. There were no issues with anyone all evening, she just saw some males (possibly 6) talking closely to V4 in what seemed like an argument in the alleyway. One of the males she describes as Tall IC1, skinny with brown hair above his ears, wearing a white shirt with a blue pattern on. Someone calls the name "Harry" at

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the group and this male turns around but she cannot be sure who is actually called Harry. She tries to intervene in the argument and the IC1 male as described pushes her away. Next thing she knows V1 has a gash to his neck and is bleeding, she does not know what happened. She did not see any weapons or who did this.

04/09/2021 09:39

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Didn't see the stabbing itself but saw the injury to V1 neck and held her hand against it until Las arrived. Top has been seized as had Lee's blood on it.

04/09/2021 09:40

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For consideration of both witnesses, at the time they had been quite shaken up after seeing the injuries to V1. To be re-approached and consideration given to ABEs.

AS916N were tasked to OP EQUINOX and were on mobile patrols heading southbound on BOROUGH HIGH STREET, SE1 when the unit was flagged down by ANTWI, a security guard of GIUSEPPE'S RISTORANTE, SE1. It was explained that a male had started a fight and had become aggressive with staff when asked to leave. This male was later identified as S1. It was understood that whilst stood in line for the bar, SA had pushed into the queue, and alleges that xxxxx and xxxxx stamped on her leg and pulled her hair in retaliation. This started a scuffle between the females which led to xxxxx getting involved. It was understood a second, unidentified male got involved with xxxxx causing the fight, leading to them being thrown out which is where police have returned, having seen a

commotion. The commotion was the security attempting to control xxxxx who was highly irate, while xxxxx and xxxxx argued in the street.

Amongst the scuffle, SA's handbag containing her passport and housekeys have gone missing. Words of advice have been given for this issue, and CCTV enquiries will be conducted.

CCTV from the scene has been reviewed by 2486AS and 2687AS. The CCTV shows an unidentified IC1 male seemingly

reasoning with SA at the bar, when xxxxx very much butts in aggressively, pressing his forehead to the other males in a violent manner. This has led to a mass brawl where approximately ten-fifteen people have got involved in the assault on various others. Many of these people were not on scene when police arrived. SA claims to have been assaulted by xxxx and xxxxx and supports prosecution. CCTV will need to be retrieved from the bar area in order to ascertain what happened.
