

Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

100 No supply of alcohol may be made under the Premises Licence -

- a. At a time when there is no Designated Premises Supervisor in respect of the Premises Licence; or
- b. At a time when the Designated Premises Supervisor does not hold a Personal Licence or his Personal Licence is suspended

101 Every supply of alcohol under the Premises Licence must be made, or authorised by, a person who holds a Personal Licence

485 (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staffs on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

(2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children –

(a) Games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require, encourage, individuals to –

(i) Drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or

(ii) Drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

(b) Provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to

an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);

(c) Provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;

(d) Provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on-

(i) The outcome of a race, competition or other event or process; or

(ii) The likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;

(e) Selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

486 The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

487 The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

488 (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2). The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

489 The responsible person shall ensure that –

(a) Where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures –

(i) Beer or cider: ½ pint;

(ii) Gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and

(iii) Still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and

(b) Customers are made aware of the availability of these measures

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

340 That CCTV shall be installed throughout the premises and will be monitored.

341 That The premises shall be fully alarmed.

342 Staff employed at the premises shall receive training in regards to dealing with rowdy customers.

343 That all fire escapes at the premises shall be clearly identified by way of signage.

344 That risk assessments shall be undertaken in regards to all relevant legislation.

345 That ample fire fighting equipment shall be kept in all areas of the premises

346 That all staff employed at the premises will receive training in regards to dealing with emergencies at the premises

347 a. The Licensee / Duty Manager shall ensure that an adequate and appropriate supply of first aid equipment and materials is available on the premises.

b. If required, at least one suitably trained first aider shall be on duty when the public are present. If more than one suitably trained first-aider is present, each person's responsibilities shall be clearly identified.

348 Drunk or unruly customers will be refused admission or asked to leave the premises.

349 The forecourt will be kept clean and free of litter.

350 A 'Challenge 21' policy shall be implemented at the premises requiring any staff involved in the sale or supply of intoxicating liquor to request photo identification comprising of a valid passport, full driving licence, PASS (Proof of Age Standards Scheme) accredited card or Citizen Card from any person attempting to buy intoxicating liquor who appears to be under 21 years of age that proves that that person is over 18 years of age.

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

840 That clearly legible signs are prominently displayed to the satisfaction of the council requesting that customers smoking and / or congregating outside of the premises do so in a quiet and orderly manner and are considerate of local residents.

841 That a direct line telephone number will be made available to local residents should local residents be caused any nuisance by the operation of the premises

842 That there shall be no 'bottling up' or movement of goods and / or refuse into or out of the premises between 23:30 to 07:00

843 If at any time after 23:30 local residents are disturbed by recorded music emanating from the premises the volume of recorded music will be reduced on request

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
