It is recommended that the Cabinet Member for Leisure Parks, Streets and Clean Air:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Retains the traffic filter at Cooks Road (junction with Otto Street) as an anytime motor vehicle prohibition using camera-enforcement with exemptions for emergency services, Southwark Blue Badge Holders, SEND vehicles, and Royal Mail. • Retains the traffic filters at Melbourne Grove North (junction with Grove Vale) and South (junction with Tell Grove) as anytime motor vehicle prohibitions using physical barriers. • Retains the parking changes on Melbourne Grove North. • Instructs officers under delegated powers to advertise a permanent traffic order(s) in respect of the above. <p>The above recommendations are subject to the statutory consultation process, should any unresolved objections be received during this period, a further report will be brought to the Cabinet Member for consideration.</p>
