Approve the implementation of a camera-enforced traffic filter on Westmoreland Road, under an Experimental Traffic Management Order (ETMO), see Appendix A. 2. Approve the removal of the traffic filter on Phelp Street under Traffic Management Order (TMO), TMO2122-037_WS Merrow Street' at the junction of Westmoreland Road to improve vehicle access and egress. 3. Instruct officers to communicate the decision through a mail-out to local residents, provided in advance to local councillors and Cabinet member. 4. Instruct officers to carry out a review with residents 6-8 months after the ETMO live date, to inform a permanent decision on the proposal.


