FOREWORD – COUNCILLOR PETER JOHN, LEADER OF THE COUNCIL

This report sets out the Council's achievements in reaching its corporate performance targets over the twelve months to April 2010.

It is evident from the Report that although some progress was made the Council failed to achieve its target for Decent Homes works, for recycling or reusing household waste and that childhood obesity remains one of the most significant health and well-being issues for our borough.

Although future versions of this report will reflect the changed political priorities of our Administration and the changes to central government's inspection of local authorities, the issues raised within this year's report will not be lost. We will be taking significant steps to ensure that every council home is made warm, dry and safe, to increase the range of household waste that can be recycled on the doorstep and the proposed introduction of free healthy school meals for all primary school children will be crucial in tackling the issue of childhood obesity.

Reports such as this are an important tool in tracking the progress and impact of policy initiatives, and we will continue to use them as an indicator of our success over the next 4 years.
