That the Deputy Leader and Cabinet Member for Children, Young People, Education & Refugees approves the award of grant funding to Beam Up Limited for the period of 1 year to cover the cost of providing services to Homes for Ukraine guests to enable their access to employment and accommodation within the private rented sector. 2. The grant will fund £150,000 to cover the costs of initial one to one support. There will also be an additional a payment-by-results element, with the Council paying Beam £2,000 for every private sector tenancy signed to provide additional 12 months of support to help sustain the tenancy (this will amount to an additional £100,000 if all 50 households are able to sign private sector tenancies).


