	Not only is the music very loud, but after the club is closed the streets becomes full of people who continue to make a noise and to play music.	
	According to Planet Nollywood's license agreement, the premise is required to adhere to specific regulations and restrictions concerning noise levels, operating hours, and the well-being of the neighborhood. Unfortunately, these stipulations have been blatantly disregarded, causing severe inconvenience to those residing nearby.	
	The disturbances caused by the premises have resulted in increased levels of stress, sleep deprivation, and a general deterioration in the quality of life for the residents. This situation is untenable and demands immediate attention and corrective action from the council.	
	I kindly request that the council investigate this matter thoroughly, conduct noise level measurements, and take the necessary steps to ensure that residents of Southward Council are able to enjoy their homes. As concerned residents, we have the right to enjoy a peaceful and quiet environment within our community, and it is crucial that the council upholds these rights.
