That the Cabinet Member for Health and Wellbeing note that the proposed grants will help implement the Sustainable Food Strategy objectives including: a good food partnership, strong and connected communities, food security and the Right to Food, healthy people, healthy planet and a good food economy and affordable food offer.			
	3. That the Cabinet Member of Health and Wellbeing note that a proportion of the grants (£40,000 per year) will be allocated to fund food-related support for older adults, a key target group of the			

Sustainable Food Strategy.
4. That the Cabinet Member of Health and Wellbeing note that £25,000 will be allocated in the first year only, to award grants for the provision of fridge-freezer appliances for the relevant food providers.
