REPRESENTATIONS RECEIVED

Representation 1:

Millwall Community Trust sent representations about their disappointment that the grant making process doesn't include an appeal stage in relation to the fact they had not been recommended for funding. They explained the work they deliver to address youth crime. They stated the recommendations would mean they would receive no funding from Southwark Council. They stated that they pay the council rent and operate and maintain a local sports ground.

Representation 2

Crystal Palace Community Trust shared a representation outlining their disappointment at the recommendation, stating that the organisation has been active in Kingswood for a number of years. They highlighted some issues they had experienced in delivering locally and their ability to access a space on the estate. They shared their credentials as an organisation and asked about ongoing support for their service users.

Representation 3

Excel Beyond Boundaries submitted a representation to express their disappointment with the recommendations. They shared a support letter from a local partner organisation stating the need for provision for Special Educational Needs individuals.

ADDITIONAL ADVICE RECEIVED

Officers advised Cllr Williams that all grant making due process were correctly followed. Applicants who were unsuccessful are offered meetings with officers to receive feedback on their bids, also to identify alternative sources of potential funding and other forms of council support for their future plans. Applicants, including those making representations will be written to by officers with more information, following this decision.
