## Background/Request

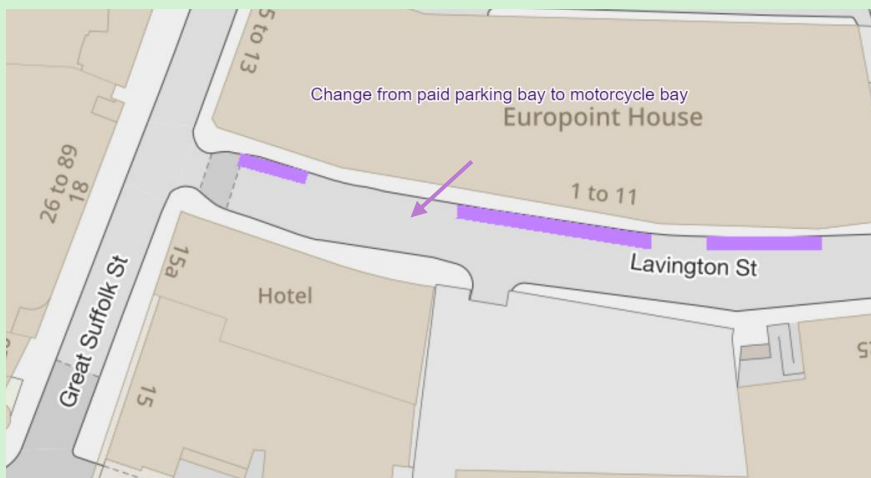
- The current motorcycle bay on Lavington Street is being used by a development as a pit lane for materials deliveries. This development is not likely to be completed until 2026.
- Motorcyclists who regularly used the motorcycle parking bay have requested that another bay on Lavington Street is made into a motorcycle parking bay.

## Background / Request

- This request came from motorcyclists who regularly park in Lavington Street.

## Location

Lavington Street junction with Great Suffolk Street.



### Investigation and conclusions

- Discussions were had with the Transport Policy Team to see if we should be providing motorcycle parking. The outcome was that we should facilitate all road users.
- The parking team have agreed to change the parking bay from paid to motorcycle.

### Recommendation

It is recommended that to change the existing paid parking bay on Lavington Street to a motorcycle parking bay.

### Next steps

Should this non-strategic Traffic and Highway improvement proposal be approved, then arrangements will be made to advertise the traffic order. Should any objections be received a further report will be brought to the Cabinet Member for consideration. If there are favourable outcomes the motorcycle bay will be installed.
