Instructs officers to make the necessary permanent Traffic Management Orders ("TMOs") in accordance with sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of the 1984 Act subject to statutory consultation carried out pursuant to the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 ("1996 Regulations"). | |

REPRESENTATIONS RECEIVED

- Concern that traders will face difficulty accessing loading bays close to Rye Lane when parking bays for e-scooters and e-bikes are implemented in Bournemouth Road.
- 2. Request to review the suitability of the parking bay at Aspinden Road and concern that the North Bermondsey location is close to Maydew House, a tower block that will require large vehicles for demolition.

ADDITIONAL ADVICE RECEIVED

- 1. This point can be addressed following implementation. Discussions will take place during a site visit to Rye Lane on 09/10/24.
- 2. Site visit conducted at Aspinden Road location on 07/10/24. Overflow to neighbouring parking bays were not found to be a safety concern or major issue, but overflow will be discussed with operators. There is not expected to be issues caused by the parking location at North Bermondsey during demolition, but monitoring for issues arising will take place.
