	Quarterly billed "tariff" supplies	Lowest consuming, quarterly billed supplies. 3,437 supplies ranging from smaller offices, primary schools, housing landlord supplies to non-building based supplies (e.g. parks and public realm supplies)	EDF	LASER Negotiated tariff fixed rate	31 st March 2014

gas	Interruptible supplies	<p>Highest consuming sites designated as “interruptible” by the gas network operator. When there is a risk of regional demand for gas exceeding supply (i.e. cold winter) “interruptible” supplies can be instructed to stop using gas within 4 hour notice. Such supplies need to switch to burning an alternative fuel – typically oil. Council has two sites – Aylesbury Estate boiler house and the Blakes Rd (ex N. Peckham Estate) boiler house.
