It is recommended to double the number of delegates and deputies from Area Forums to Tenant Council, with consideration being given to proportional representation along the lines of Leaseholder Council.

DECISION(S)

1. It is NOT agreed that the name of the Bermondsey One-Stop shop be changed, but that it remain Bermondsey One-Stop shop.

It is further recommended that officers look at the postal address to be given to the Bermondsey One- Stop Shop to see if the words " Alfred Salter House" might be incorporated into the address of the new facility.

- 2. It is NOT agreed that the name of the Bermondsey West Forum be changed. The Executive was determined that Area Forums should contain the distinct geographic location in their names.
- 3. It is NOT agreed to amend the boundaries of the 3 Area Forums in the Walworth Housing Area.
- 4. It is agreed that Area Forums have 2 delegates and two deputies to the next Tenant Council as an interim arrangement, but that officers produce an item for that same Tenant Council on proportional representation at Tenant Council, this should then be referred with Tenant Council recommendations to the next scheduled Area Forums for consideration. Those considerations to be referred back to the subsequent Tenant Council for a definitive recommendation on future Tenant Council representation.

REASONS FOR DECISION

- The Bermondsey One Stop Shop will provide a wider remit than just housing to an area coterminus with the Bermondsey Community Council area, not just that area previously covered by the Alfred Salter Neighbourhood Housing Office. As such it needs to be distinctly linked to the Bermondsey Area.
- 2. The Bermondsey West Area Forum will cover a different area than that covered by the Alfred Salter Neighbourhood Forum. The Executive was determined that Area Forums should contain the distinct geographic location in their names.
- 3. The Executive considered a number of representations regarding the division of the Walworth Area into 3 Housing Area Forums before reaching its decision to base the division on the existing 3 ward boundaries covered by the area. It has built in a 12-month review period to assess the workings of Area Forums; therefore any decision to reverse this arrangement should await the outcome of that process.
- 4. The current Area Forums constitution allows for one delegate and one deputy to Tenant Council, but it is appreciated that this will reduce the number of Tenant Council delegates selected from forums from 17 to 13 delegates. It is therefore reasonable to allow Tenant Council to appoint 2 delegates from each forum as an interim arrangement until such time as other options can be considered. It is equitable to consider proportional representation for Tenant Council, as Leaseholder Council has used this method for the selection of forum delegates for a number of years.
