Appendix C - Community Council summary

As part of the Transport Plan consultation officers attended all eight community councils in January and February 2011. The approach was tailored to the needs of each meeting and included presentations, workshops, real time voting on key issues and informal discussions with councillors and local people. All attendees were invited to complete our questionnaire on key issues raised by the Plan.

Particular issues raised are summarised below.

- Bermondsey Community Council highlighted the need to support local businesses when considering parking policy. There was less support for night time deliveries to relieve day time congestion.
- Camberwell Community Council raised the issue of cyclist safety and inconsiderate cycling, with a particular interest in the Mayor's cycle superhighway programme. Road maintenance was also raised.
- Nunhead and PR Community Council raised the issue of bus services in the local area and noted the general contents of the Plan.
- Borough and Bankside Community Council highlighted the need to provide quiet routes for cyclists, strongly supported the proposed 20 mph policy and the potential for night time deliveries.
- Dulwich Community Council highlighted concerns about poor public transport provision in the area, in relation to both bus and rail services.
- No specific feedback was received from Rotherhithe, Peckham or Walworth Community Councils.
