APPENDIX 1 – PROJECT STREAMS

All the project streams are to be finalised following consultation. Potential areas of work include but are not limited to those outlined below:

- Solar Hot Water Scheme Over £400,000 has already been awarded to the council by the GLA in respect of energy efficiency / solar hot water works specifically within the renewal areas. In addition to this, part of the renewal area has now been confirmed as a Low Carbon Zone by the GLA, attracting a further £300,000. The zone is supported by British Gas 4 and the Council are working with them to deliver substantial investment through a Community Energy Savings Programme (CESP) scheme.
- **Group Repair Scheme** Works to private, council owned and housing association properties have been completed under a single contract in Astbury and Colls Roads. Initial consultation has recently taken place for a similar scheme in Furley, Marmont and Goldsmith Roads.
- **Lighting** working with the Low Carbon Zone initiative and Public Realm to improve street lighting and install LED / low maintenance lamps to address resident concerns about personal safety and crime prevention.
- Shop Fronts to continue, develop and expand the work undertaken under the Investment in Local Retail Environmental (ILRE) programme (Meeting House Lane, Nunhead Lane, Evelina and Queens Road) particularly to Nunhead Green and Evelina Road to ensure vibrant and economically viable shopping areas.
- Queens Road Station supporting improvements undertaken with TfL and Network Rail to improve accessibility and safety of the station and its environment.
- **Environmental Improvements** may include (but are not limited to) tree planting, upgraded pavements, traffic calming, feature lighting, seating and public art, linked to the projects outlined above.
