30.	Re-open Post Office on Gibbon Road with ATM, ramps to lower speeds of cars, especially Gibbon Road. More community use of public space and churches. Extend grants or insulation, solar panel and home improvements.
31.	More improvements for pedestrians e.g. zebra crossing on Nunhead Lane and Evelina Road. Extend garden wall scheme to other roads.
32.	Nunhead: traffic calming on Evelina (thru shopping area); Pedestrian crossing (zebra) opposite butcher; Investment in shopfronts.
