	Westmoreland Road	General / Bric-A-Brac	Sun	61	De-designate Sunday trading at Westmoreland Road.	There have been major works in the area and there has been a big problem with anti social behaviour involving street drinkers and drug addicts. These traders are now trading successfully in East Street.
	Westmoreland Road	General / Bric-A-Brac	Mon – Sat	61	De-designate 55 pitches, leaving 6 at the junction of Walworth Road.	Since 2005 there have been no more than 2 / 3 traders, trading Monday to Saturday. Locating the pitches at the junction of Walworth Road would be more beneficial for remaining and any new traders.
	Bermondsey Antiques Market	Antiques	Friday	261	Reduce designation from 261 to 150 pitches.	This market was originally known as New Caledonian Market with 261 stalls. Following major regeneration there is now only space for a maximum of 150 pitches.
	East Street Market	General	Tue – Sun	244	Reduce designation from 244 pitches to 200.	Pitches have been extended from 9ft to 12ft pitches with a 3ft gap every second pitch this has reduced the amount of pitches from 244 to 200. Traders have requested this change.
	Tower Bridge Road	General	Mon – Sat	42	De-designate the market.	During the development of Bermondsey Antiques Market a red

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						route TFL road was built through part of the market which restricted traders ability to trade and created parking issues. The market went into decline and didn't recover. The only trader now has a shop front licence.
	Choumert Road	General	Mon – Sat	30	Reduce designation to 5 pitches.	This market has gone into decline; there are 5 stalls each week that are linked to existing shop tenants. We would wish these to remain for the present.
	Bermondsey Street	Antiques	Friday	19	De-designate the market	Redevelopment has removed pitch space
	Horsley Street	Bric-A-Brac	Sunday	17	De-designate the market.	This was an extension of Westmoreland Road when it was flourishing. These pitches haven't been used for at least 5 years as they are no longer viable.
	Arnside Street	General	Mon – Sat	3	De-Designate	There was one trader up until late 2005, since his retirement these pitches haven't been utilised and are not viable.
	Dog Kennel Hill	Newsvendor	Mon – Sat	1	De-designate	This pitch has not been utilised in a good 10 years.

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	Mission Place	General	Mon – Sat	1	De-Designate	This hasn't been utilised in the past 6 years through redevelopment of the area. If a pitch was sited here it would cause an obstruction.
	Joiner Street	General	Mon – Sat	1	De-designate	This appears to have been developed out by the Shard
	Sumner Road	Newsvendor	Mon – Sun	1	De-designate	This was deemed as dangerous as the trader was robbed on more than two occasions. The receptacle was removed as part of a CGS project as it was deemed a fire hazard.
	The Triangle	General	Sat & Sun	1	De-Designate	This has been developed over and trees have been planted.
	Railway Approach	Newsvendor	Mon – Sat	1	De-designate	This pitch has been swallowed up by the Shard.
