Voluntary Sector Day Services and Lunch Clubs and Community Support

Decisions:

That Overview & Scrutiny Committee:

- 1. Notes the independent report by the National Council for Voluntary Organisations that the government's cuts will lead to a reduction in funding to the voluntary and community sector of £2.8 billion.
- Notes the disproportionate impact of the government's cuts on Southwark with £34 million of cuts in 2011/12 compared to just £1 million in London's most affluent borough, Richmond-on-Thames.
- 3. Notes that the council's statutory responsibilities mean that difficult decisions must be made in terms of discretionary spending.
- Notes the government's strong commitment to the personalisation agenda and that the council is obliged to provide personal budgets to service users.
- 5. Asks the cabinet to ensure that the assessment of current service users for personal budgets is completed as soon as possible.
- 6. Asks the cabinet to continue engaging with voluntary groups during the transitional period and to ensure that officers continue to provide advice and support to the voluntary groups.
- 7. Agrees not to refer the decision back to the cabinet.
