Care Quality Commission

The Care Quality Commission is the new health and social care regulator for England. They look at the joined up picture of health and social care and their aim is to ensure better care for everyone in hospital, in a care home and at home.

They regulate:

- Providers of medical and clinical treatment and care given to people of all ages, including treatment given in hospitals, ambulance services, and mental health services. They will eventually include primary care such as GP and dental practices.
- Providers of care services for adults in residential homes, in the community and in people's own homes. They focus on people who find themselves in vulnerable circumstances, including those with mental health problems, learning disabilities, physical disabilities or long-term health conditions and older people.
- Providers of services for people whose rights are restricted under the Mental Health Act.

Quality Account

A Quality Account is a report about the quality of services provided by an NHS healthcare service. The report is published annually by each NHS healthcare provider and available to the public. Quality Accounts aim to enhance

accountability to the public and engage the leaders of an organisation in their quality improvement agenda. The first statutory Quality Accounts were published in June 2010 covering activity for 2009/10. All healthcare providers or sub-contractors of NHS services are required to produce a Quality Account but for its first year only not in relation to the provision of any primary care or community health services. The regulations state that Quality Accounts must be published by June 30 each year following the end of the reporting period.
