The Licensing Unit has in the past received complaints and is still receiving complaints about the operation of your public house and the impact it is having on your neighbours (especially during the month of August) . The issues that needs attention are:

1. The level of noise (from both music and people) that emanates from your premises and the disturbances caused outside the premises by your patrons
2. The fact that your customers use the pavement/highway as an extension of your toilet facilities.

I have checked the licensing database and noted that visits have been conducted by both Licensing, Environmental Protection teams and Police officers and verbal warnings have been given on site.

I will advice you at this stage that the licensing unit is of the view that you do not or refuse to exercise proper management control over your patrons.

The Licensing Act now has now given the Licensing Unit the mandate to request for a review of licences and the Unit will do so if the need arises.

This letter is your last and formal warning licence with regards to these issues, and if anymore complaints are received and is supported by evidence by council officers then a review of your licence will be requested.
