DETAILS OF THE REPORT

Report Title: Setting fees and charges for Burgess Park BMX track

Summary of decision: That the Cabinet Member agrees the proposed non-statutory fees and charges for the Burgess Park BMX track for 2013/14 with an implementation date of 6 August 2013.

Reasons for urgency:

- The decision was not listed on the forward plan because the issue relating to proposing fees and charges for the BMX track has just been resolved.
- The next forward plan relates to decisions to be taken from September 2013 onwards. The BMX track is due to open in Burgess Park on the 6 August and as such the fees and charges need to be approved by this date in order that they can be applied once the track is opened.
- If the decision was to wait for inclusion in the next forward plan it would mean that there would be a period of time from the 6 August where fees and charges could not be applied which would equate to a loss of approximately £2,000
- The new BMX track at Burgess Park is an Olympic Legacy project and as such a Fairer Future Promise of the Council. The opening of the track is key to increasing participation in sport and fulfilling the objectives of the Olympic Legacy programme and as such it is imperative that the operation of the track is a success from the day of opening (6 august).
