Police are in receipt of an application from the above for a new Premises Licence to be granted under the licensing act 2003. Some of the following conditions may have been already offered by the applicant as part of the operating schedule but the wording of each condition is vital to negate any ambiguity.

- That a CCTV system be installed at the premises and be maintained in good working order and be continually recording at all times the premises are in use under the licence. The CCTV System must be capable of capturing a clear facial image of every person who enters the premises.
- That all CCTV footage shall be kept for a period of thirty one (31) days and shall, upon request, be made immediately available to Officers of the Police and the Council
- 3. No beers / ciders in single cans, bottles or multi-packs with an ABV of above 7% will be displayed / sold or offered for sale from the premises.

- 4. No Alcohol to be displayed or stored within 2 metres of the entrance door.
- 5. When the premises are open to the public and the licence is not in operation. All alcohol shall be stored in a locked cabernet/cooler, behind a lockable blind or behind the counter.
- 6. That all staff are trained in their responsibilities under the licensing act 2003 and training records to be kept and updated every 6 months and shall, upon request, be made immediately available to Officers of the Police and the Council.

I confirm that the following conditions are agreed:-

- 3. No super strength beer, lager or cider of 5.5% abv or above shall be sold other than premium beer, lager or cider priced at £1.95 or above".
- 4. There will be no self service display of alcohol within 2 metres of the entrance door.
- 5. That all staff are trained in their responsibilities under the Licensing Act 2003 and training records to be kept and updated every 6 months and shall, upon request, be made immediately available to Officers of the Police and the Council.
