Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

100 No supply of alcohol may be made under the Premises Licence -

a.At a time when there is no Designated Premises Supervisor in respect of the Premises Licence; or b.At a time when the Designated Premises Supervisor does not hold a Personal Licence or his Personal Licence is suspended

101 Every supply of alcohol under the Premises Licence must be made, or authorised by, a person who holds a Personal Licence

485 (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

(2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children

(a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require, encourage, individuals to

(i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or

(ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

(b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);

(c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;

(d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on-

(i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process; or

(ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;

(e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

486 The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

487 The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

488 (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification

policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2). The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

489 The responsible person shall ensure that -

(a) Where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures -

(i) Beer or cider: 1/2 pint;

(ii) Gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and

(iii) Still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and

(b) Customers are made aware of the availability of these measures

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

288 That the CCTV system installed upon the premises shall be maintained in good working condition and operable at all times

289 That recordings taken by the CCTV system installed upon the premises shall be kept and made available for inspection by authorised officers for a period of thirty one (31) days

298 That suitable notices shall be displayed stating "No Drugs".

309 That all musicians and DJs must play electrically amplified music/audio/PA through a sound cut out device. The cut-out device shall be maintained at levels set to the satisfaction of the Council's Noise Team **311** That notices shall be displayed requesting that customers leave the premises in a quiet and orderly manner

316 That deliveries and waste disposal will be restricted to between 0730 and 0000 hours Monday to Saturday and 1000 and 2300 hours on Sunday

323 That the management make regular hourly checks to ensure that patrons attending the premises do not cause nuisance or noise in the surrounding area both prior to attending and after leaving the premises **326** That all appropriate staff shall be trained in the age identification scheme required at the premises and records of training shall be kept and made available for inspection by authorised officers of the Council **332** All children on the premises under 18 will be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult at all times **334** That an age identification scheme shall be established and maintained. The scheme shall Require the production of evidence of age (comprising any PASS accredited card or passport or driving licence) from any person appearing to staff enagaged in selling or supplying alcohol to be under the age of 18 and who is attempting to buy alcohol

340 That the premises will not have gaming machines, nor publically available cigarette machines

341 That the staff policy will be given to staff on joining and they will be made aware of the seriousness of any deviation from it

342 That staff will be trained to request customers do not remove open containers from the premises

343 That the entrance to the premises will be lobbied to reduce sound emission

344 That exit doors will be fitted with automatic closure devices to reduce noise escape and both fire doors will be alarmed

345 That windows will not be left open after 2300 hours in any circumstances
