Framework Approach

The proposed procurement strategy is to utilise two existing framework agreements contracted by Peabody and the Hyde Group to procure architectural services for the majority of the sites in Phase 2 and future phases which come on stream within the life of the frameworks. The use of these frameworks is not exhaustive and could be utilised throughout the council for the wider delivery of new homes and other non-housing capital works.
