## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

### Community evidence on the theme

### Submissions

#### 1. STEP UP – The Upwardly Mobile Network

To promote the new STEP Up project. Step Up is a project that focuses on employment and supports people who are in work but perhaps on low hours or low pay. Our aim is to support clients to achieve increased hours and to attain the London Living Wage.

Step Up, the Upwardly Mobile Network, is a service to help people in low-paid jobs learn new skills and find better work with better pay. It provides one-to-one support, as well as help in making contact with potential new employers. Access to key skills training is also available in subjects such as English, Maths and IT.

#### 2. Construction Youth Trust

To inform councillors about our programmes as a way of networking and reaching more community partner organisations through the councillors. My five minute presentation would entail information on our courses; and our vision for young Southwark residents and the community. I would be able to explain what makes our programmes successful and how they can be delivered to residents.

As a training organisation based in Southwark, we are supporting young people (16-30 years of age) who are not in employment, education or training (NEET). Our programmes include the Level 1 qualification in Health and Safety in the Construction Environment and CSCS cards as well as work experience placements, preparing young people for accessing the construction industry; and creating opportunities for community cohesion and outreach.
