Dear Sir/Madam

Police are in possession of an application from the above for a new premises licence, the application is for the sale of alcohol on the premises only between the hours of 12:00 and 21:00 Monday to Saturday and 17.00hrs Sunday, with a terminal hour of 22.00hrs & 18.00hrs respectively.

The application contains a number of control measures. Police would like to see a minimum of the following control measures placed on the licence some of which may have already been offered as part of the application but the wording is important to avoid ubiquity.

1. That a CCTV system be installed at the premises and be maintained in good working order and be continually recording at all times the premises are in use under the licence. The CCTV System must be capable of capturing a clear facial image of every person who enters the premises.
2. All CCTV footage be kept for a period of 31 days and shall on request be made immediately available to officers of the police and the council. There will be at least one person on duty at all times that is familiar with the operation of the CCTV and able to download the footage upon reasonable request.
3. That all staff are trained in their responsibilities under the licensing act 2003 and training records to be kept and updated every 6 months and shall, upon request, be made immediately available to Officers of the Police and the Council.
4. Intoxicating liquor shall not be sold or supplied on the premises otherwise than to persons taking table meals there and for consumption by such person as an ancillary to his meal.

The Following is submitted for your consideration, Police would welcome the opportunity to conciliate should the need arise.

We have considered the matter and have **no objection**.

The proposed hours for the sale and consumption of alcohol on premises as well as the hours of recorded music comply with condition 5 of planning permission 15/AP/2595 which state that

*'the use hereby permitted for a café shall not be carried on outside of the hours 07:30 to 22.00hrs on any day. External seating areas shall be closed outside the hours of 08.00 to 20.00hrs on any day.'*

*This is 'to safeguard the amenity of neighbouring residential properties in accordance with The National Planning Policy Framework 2012, Strategic Policy 13 High environmental standards of The Core Strategy 2011 and Saved Policy 3.2 Protection of Amenity of The Southwark Plan 2007.*
