The Variation is proposed to amend the hours of the Licensable activities and hours open to public to suite the premises operation and culture. The Premises is Bar/Restaurant with a South American cultural feel and cuisine.

**a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)**

The premises is a Bar/Restaurant which provides Brazilian cuisine and entertainment. The premises is below a commercial hotel premises and operates under a lease from the Hotel Management.

**b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

1. The premises will operate CCTV system that is acceptable to the Police Licensing Officer and record images for a period of 31 days.
2. Door staff will be employed on Fridays and Saturday nights from 2200 hours until the premises are closed.
3. Notices will be displayed informing patrons that random searches will be carried out and patrons who refuse such searches will not be admitted. (Fridays and Saturdays)
4. Regular Toilet checks will be carried out and recorded. (Fridays and Saturdays)
5. The last entry will be one hour before end of sale of alcohol ends. (Fridays and Saturdays)

**c) Public safety**

6. Local Taxi numbers will be available for patrons to call.
7. Hot drinks and snacks will be available until 30 minutes before closure

**d) The prevention of public nuisance**

8. The music will be kept to a level that will not cause a nuisance to neighbouring premises
9. Notices will be displayed requesting customers to leave quietly.

**e) The protection of children from harm**

10. A challenge 25 Policy will be in place

11. No one under the age of 18 will be admitted to the premises on Saturdays and Sundays after midnight.





## Notes for Guidance

**This application cannot be used to vary the licence so as to extend the period for which the licence has effect or to vary substantially the premises to which it relates. If you wish to make that type of change to the premises licence, you should make a new premises licence application under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.**

1. You do not have to pay a fee if the only purpose of the variation for which you are applying is to avoid becoming liable to the late night levy.
