Title of Report	Southwark Regeneration in Partnership Programme (SSRP) Lot A4 - Former Cherry Garden School - Disposal of Lease
Description/Nature of matter requiring Key Decision	To seek approval for disposal of the site of former Cherry Gardens School, Macks Road SE16 for development of 56 new homes, of which 18 will be council homes to Higgins Homes Plc - who have been selected in line with the procurement strategy agreed by cabinet on 21 March 2017.
Decision taker	Strategic Director of Place and Wellbeing
Date by which Key Decision must be taken	February 2019
Reason why it was impracticable for decision to be on the Forward Plan	The report relating to the SRPP Lot A4 contract award was approved in January 2019. The officer report however did not address the matter of the disposal of the lease of which approval is now being sought.
Reason why the decision cannot wait for inclusion in the next Forward Plan	The next forward plan to be published relates to decisions to be taken from March 2019 onwards. The contract award has been approved and the council seeks to execute the development agreement as soon as possible to avoid risk of non delivery of the project.
