The principal changes we are proposing include:

The introduction of a controlled parking zone to prioritise parking for residents

Section A An improved crossing for cyclists and pedestrians at the junction of Wells Way and St George's Way

Section B Closing St George's Way to through motor traffic, with a barrier east of Chandler Way

Section C Installation of a two-way cycle track on part of Commercial Way and changes to the crossing at Moody Road to help cyclists and pedestrians cross Commercial Way

Section D Footway widening at the junction of Kelly Avenue and Peckham Road to give more space for pedestrians and cyclists

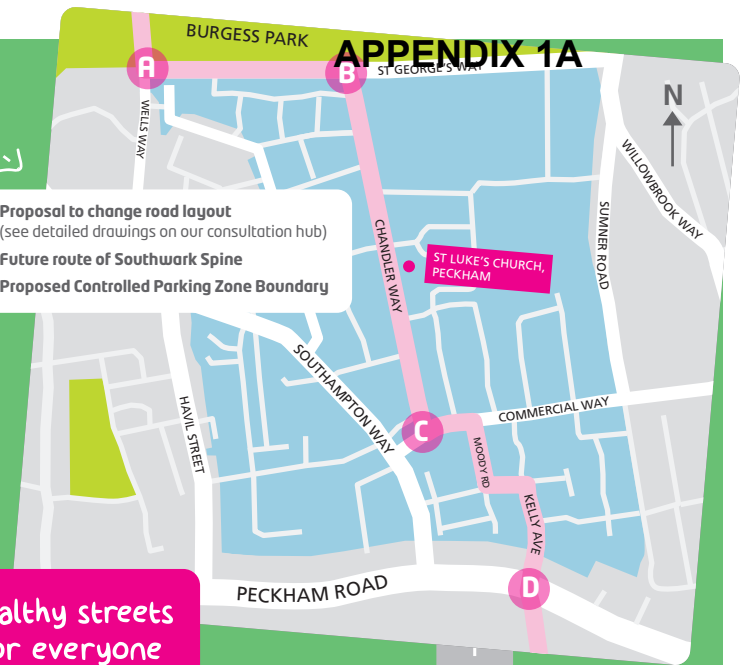
