That the Cabinet Member for Children, Schools and Adult Care, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Housing Management and Modernisation, approves the award of two contracts for the 16+ Support and Resettlement Services to Oasis Aquila Housing and The Salvation Army for a period of 4 years from 1 July 2019 with an option to extend for a further 2 years (1+1). The total estimated maximum value of both contracts for 4 years is £5.6m as further detailed in paragraph 32, with an estimated maximum contract value of £8.6m should the contract extensions be used for both contracts.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Contract A (North) Oasis Aquila Housing – Total estimated maximum contract value £2.8m (4 years). - Contract B (South) The Salvation Army –Total estimated maximum contract value £2.8m (4 years). <p>2.
