Approves the implementation of a new parking zone in the North Peckham area, operating Monday to Friday, 8.30am to 6.30pm, subject to the outcome of any necessary statutory procedures.</li> <li>2. Notes that a further report will be brought should there be any statutory objections to the traffic order required to implement the new parking zone.</li> <li>3. Approves the position and type of parking bays and restrictions for the new parking zone and surrounding streets as shown in the outline design save for any amendments which may be required at the implementation stage which may be determined by officers (Appendix 2).</li> <li>4. Approves the proposed junction changes on Wells Way, St George's Way and Commercial Way to facilitate safer walking and cycling, subject to the necessary statutory procedures and minor changes resulting from the detailed design process. (Appendix 2) It should be noted that St George's Way closure would be under an experimental traffic management order.</li> </ol>
