GENERAL EXCEPTION NOTICE

DETAILS OF DECISION	
Title of Report	Harper Road and Bath Terrace trial width restrictions – Recommendation for width restrictions to be made permanent
Description/Nature of matter requiring Key Decision	To approve the retention, under a permanent traffic order, of a width restriction at Bath Terrace operating as two 2 metre lanes reinforced with a central traffic island and bollards.
Decision taker	Cabinet Member for Environment, Transport and the Climate Emergency
Date by which Key Decision must be taken	June 2019
Reason why it was impracticable for decision to be on the Forward Plan	The decision was included in the Forward Plan for February 2019. It was however not possible to finalise the officer report in time for a decision to be taken within that period. Due to error the decision was not included in subsequent Forward Plans.
Reason why the decision cannot wait for inclusion in the next Forward Plan	The next Forward Plan to be published relates to decision to be taken from July 2019 onwards. The experimental order of the current restrictions was dated 18 January 2018 and is only valid for a maximum of 18 months under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and will expire in July 2019. In order to ensure that the width restrictions are made permanent before the expiration of the experimental order a decision needs to be taken in June 2019.
