## RECOMMENDATION

1. That cabinet considers whether or not to hear a deputation from the Southwark Group of Tenant Organisations.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

2. When considering whether to hear the deputation request, cabinet can decide:
  - To receive the deputation at this meeting or a future meeting; or
  - That the deputation not be received; or
  - To refer the deputation to the most appropriate committee/sub-committee.
3. A deputation shall consist of no more than six people, including its spokesperson. Only one member of the deputation shall be allowed to address the meeting for no longer than five minutes. After this time cabinet members may ask questions of the deputation for up to five minutes. At the conclusion of the questions, the deputation will be shown to the public area where they may listen to the remainder of the open section of the meeting.

## KEY ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

4. The deadline for receipt of deputation requests for this cabinet meeting was midnight 12 June 2019. The above request is being considered as a late request, as it was received after constitutional deadline.

## Deputation requests

### Southwark Group of Tenant Organisations

5. The Southwark Group of Tenant Organisations (SGTO) wish to address cabinet on the resident involvement review cabinet report (agenda item 12) in which decisions are being made on the area housing forums, tenant council and homeowner council. The group say that there was little inclusion of the tenant management organisations (TMOs), and wish to highlight the concerns of those they represent to the cabinet, as this was an extremely important narrative when discussing the future of resident engagement in the borough.

## Community impact statement

6. The Southwark Constitution allows for deputations to be made by groups of people resident or working in the borough.
