Title of Report	Gateway 3 Variation Decision: Extension of contract - Adult Integrated Drug and Alcohol Treatment System (AIDATS)
Description/Nature of matter requiring Key Decision	Approval of the extension of the AIDATS contract with change, grow, live services limited (egls; a wholly owned, non-charitable, trading subsidiary of change grow live; a registered charity delivering health and welfare services) for a maximum period of fifteen (15) months commencing on 4 January 2020 at a maximum contract value of £4,298,023.

<u>Reason why it was impracticable for decision to be on the Forward Plan</u>	<u>The Forward Plan for decisions to be taken from October 2019 onwards was published at the beginning of September. A request was made to the Leader of the Council in September 2019 to delegate the decision from Cabinet to the Cabinet Member for Community Safety and Public Health with the intention of the decision being taken in November 2019. The Leader's agreement was required before the decision could be added to the Forward Plan. The Leader has indicated however that the decision will remain with Cabinet for which the next two scheduled meetings prior to the expiry of the contract are 29 October and 10 December 2019.</u>
<u>Reason why it was impracticable for decision to be on the Forward Plan</u>	<p>A number of internal and external factors influenced the ability to finalise the report, with particular reference to 2020/21 Public Health budgets, prior to the commencement of the three month contractual notice period on 4 October 2019.</p> <p>A request was initially made to the Leader in September 2019 to delegate the decision from Cabinet to the Cabinet Member for Community Safety and Public Health. This was due to the aforementioned three month contractual notice period and the need to give the provider as much notice as possible of the council's intentions. The Leader's decision was awaited before the item was able to be added to the Forward Plan. The Leader has confirmed, on 17 October 2019, that he would like the decision to be considered by Cabinet. As such, there is urgency for this item to be added to the Forward Plan and considered at the Cabinet meeting of 29 October 2019.</p>
<u>Reason why the decision</u>	The contract is due to expire on 3 January 2020 and
