Rotherhithe Movement Plan – Help us change your streets

You may have already received the consultation flyer we recently sent to all addresses across the Rotherhithe peninsula regarding a number of projects we are currently consulting on.

The projects include:

- The introduction of a controlled parking zone to mitigate against the expected increase in parking stress following the completion of the proposed developments.
- Changes to the Lower Road one way system to make streets two-way to reduce motor vehicle dominance and improve the shopping environment.
- The continuation of Transport for London's successful Cycleway 4 consultation to include the Lower Road section which was left out to allow us to work on making streets two way.
- The proposed introduction of a cycle route between Hawkstone Road and Rotherhithe Street to meet cycling demand.

Our intention is to enable people to lead more active lives, by providing better cycling and walking environments while maintaining and improving your current quality of life by mitigating the effect that any new developments will have on parking and how you travel.

We know that the proposals will have an effect on the way that people travel to your business and we would like to hold a workshop specifically to discuss how we can adapt our designs to suit your needs.

Please come to the Osprey Estate TRA hall on 25 July 2019 between 6 and 8pm to discuss the proposals and meet with the officers leading on the project. If you cannot
