Representations from Cllr Cryan, Cllr Williams & Cllr Whittam regarding the placement of the cycle way in conjunction with drop curbs. Further representations suggesting a pause to the temporary cycle way in favor of proceeding with the permanent cycle way as part of the wider plans to remove the gyratory system

Representations received from local residents highlighting four areas that they suggested may experience local disruptions.

**ADDITIONAL ADVICE RECEIVED**Peckham Rye (East)

Officers to install waiting restrictions on Consort Road in section identified as a problem area. Officers to request TfL to remove currently banned right turn from Nunhead Lane into Peckham Rye (West)

Burbage Road

Rationale for proposed operational timings provided to cllrs providing representation. Officers agreed to review and monitor effectiveness of measures with reduced operational timings to be implemented if appropriate.

Lower Road

Lower Road Site visit. Meeting with officers on 29<sup>th</sup> October 30, 2020 to discuss the representations and discuss the alternative placement of Cycle way 4 installation and the practical issues highlighted by those sending representations.


