

# Over the previous week

7am, Weds 2<sup>nd</sup> Dec:

Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine is approved for use by the MHRA



7am, Tues 8<sup>th</sup> Dec:

The first patient in the UK gets vaccinated outside of clinical trials




8am, Tues 8<sup>th</sup> Dec:

First south east London patient gets vaccinated at Guy's

# Overview of the Programme to date

- The target set nationally is to vaccinate **75% of the adult population**
- For south east London, this will mean vaccinating **1,006,000 people**



# How our population will receive the vaccine

There are now five delivery models for Covid vaccination:

## 1. Hospital sites delivered by NHS Trusts

- Focus on over 80s, care home staff and some frontline health workers
- Opening in two tranches
  1. Denmark Hill, PRUH and Guys – went live on 8<sup>th</sup> Dec
  2. Lewisham Hospital, QEH, QMH, St Thomas' – opening dates TBC depending on vaccine supply
- All care homes have been contacted to offer vaccination to their staff



## 2. Primary Care Networks (PCNs)

- Groups of general practices working together in local neighbourhoods
- Will focus initially on over 80s and then expand to include other older people and people who are 'at risk' due to their medical conditions
- Likely to cover care home residents once there is sufficient vaccine
- All PCNs have expressed interest in providing Covid vaccinations
- The first six PCNs in south east London (one per SEL borough) will go live on Mon 14<sup>th</sup> Dec
- Subsequent 'waves' of PCN sites to open on 16<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> Dec

# How our population will receive the vaccine



## 3. Mass vaccination centres have been identified and secured

- One per borough to start with, then additional centres if there is demand outside of the hospital and PCN sites
- These are ready to be fitted out with equipment and IT, and staffed, when we have future vaccine supply confirmed

## 4. Community pharmacies

- Small number of sites that meet stringent criteria, including 8am-8pm opening, seven days a week
- Further information to be published on 18<sup>th</sup> Dec, with a view to pharmacies delivering Covid vaccines from January

## 5. ‘Roving’ services that will vaccinate housebound people and those who cannot travel to one of the other delivery sites

- Further information is awaited on timescales
- It is likely that we will need a second vaccine to be approved that does not require such stringent storage and transport conditions

# How we are supporting delivery

---

## Workforce

- Large scale recruitment of vaccinators and of other support staff
- Training including using the national training offer and a south east London specific induction
- Holding a ‘cloud bank’ for staff to be deployed across the system, in hospitals, general practice, and mass vaccination centres

## Estates

- Securing leases, cleaning contracts, waste disposal, infection control, PPE, signage and more
- Preparing for sites to run smoothly, especially where these are not existing healthcare premises, such as town halls

# How we are supporting delivery

---

## IT

- Identifying patients from each eligible cohort
- Making sure their record is updated with their jabs
- Making sure people go back after 28 days for the second dose
- Monitoring our uptake in localities, borough and across south east London to see whether people are taking up the vaccine and work with communities where there is low uptake

## Communications

- With our population, to promote uptake and allay concerns
- With our staff across health, social care and care homes
- With each other – a vaccination programme of this scale has and will continue to require a coordinated ‘joint effort’ from all ICS partners
